GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Grant applications for One805, Inc. a 501(c)(3) registered public charity, may be submitted at any time in accordance with the guidelines that follow. Funding decisions will be based on availability of funds, impact on public safety equitably across Santa Barbara County and other Advisory Council and Board considerations.

Application Process

1. Anyone or any organization addressing a public safety need within Santa Barbara County is welcome to apply and submit an application.
2. If applying on behalf of any type of organization or public safety department, internal approval must be noted and signed by the highest ranking member/official/employee before applying for a One805 grant.
3. Email a completed application via a .pdf attachment to info@One805.org for consideration.

What is eligible for a One805 grant?

Applications may be submitted for items and initiatives that are not covered in an existing organization's budget. Examples that may qualify for funding include safety equipment, special training, and community programs that will enhance the safety and well-being of the residents of Santa Barbara County.

What is ineligible?

Personnel expenses, staff salaries, standard equipment, supplies or other items typically included in an organization's budget are not eligible for grants. Initiatives executed or items used outside of Santa Barbara County.

Grant Consideration Process

Your application will be reviewed and voted on by the Executive Board, Advisory Council and Honorary Board. Funding is dependent on available donated funds as well as the priority of your request in relation to other needs.

Your application will be considered "open" until it is either funded, no longer a need or declined. If declined, you will be notified within 30 days of submitting a grant application. If you have not been notified after 30 days of submission, your grant was accepted and awaiting funding.
